Luxury Crochet Coffee Rug Pattern – Complete Step-by-Step Guide (US Terms)

This Luxury Crochet Coffee Rug Pattern is written using standard US crochet terminology. The rug is worked in the round from the center outward, maintaining structured increases to ensure a flat and professional circular shape. The scalloped edge adds a refined luxury finish.

Materials & Tools (US Standard)

- Bulky weight cotton yarn – Brown and Cream/White
- Crochet hook 6.0 mm – 8.0 mm
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Scissors
- Non-slip backing (optional)

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- dc – double crochet
- inc – increase (2 stitches in same stitch)

Center Base – Round-by-Round Instructions

- Round 1: Magic ring, 12 dc into ring. Join with sl st.
- Round 2: Ch 3, 1 dc in same stitch. 2 dc in each stitch around. (24 dc)
- Round 3: Ch 3, *1 dc in next stitch, 2 dc in next stitch.* Repeat around. (36 dc)
- Round 4: *2 dc, inc.* Repeat around.
- Round 5: *3 dc, inc.* Repeat around.
- Continue increasing evenly each round to maintain a flat circle.

Color Changes & Coffee Cup Motif

Follow the chart to change colors precisely where the cup motif appears. Change yarn color at the last yarn-over of the previous stitch for clean transitions. Carry unused yarn neatly along the back or fasten off to prevent bulk.

Outer Texture Section

Alternate sc and dc stitches in the brown section to create texture. Maintain consistent tension. If the rug ripples, reduce increases. If it curls inward, add one extra increase round.

Scalloped Border

Skip 1 stitch, 5 dc in next stitch, skip 1 stitch, sl st in next stitch. Repeat around entire edge. Fasten off and weave in ends securely.

Finishing & Care

Steam block lightly to shape the rug. Do not press directly with an iron. Attach non-slip backing if needed. Hand wash in cold water and lay flat to dry.
