This adorable plush combines a peanut butter & jelly sandwich with a jellyfish! Follow carefully and you'll be able to make it from start to finish, even as a beginner.


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COMPLETE TUTORIAL: AMIGURUMI PB&J JELLYFISH (LIFE-SIZE)




Materials: Thick Chenille/Blanket Yarn (Size 6 Super Bulky in Toast Brown, Cream, Purple, Yellow), 6.5mm (K-10.5) Hook, 12mm Safety Eyes, Poly-Fill, Tapestry Needle, Stitch Marker.

US STANDARD STITCHES




STEP 1: BREAD BODY (x2) - Color A (Cream)

Start a MR with 6 sc




Rnd 1: MR with 6 sc
Rnd 2: inc x6
Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x6
Rnd 4: (sc, inc) x6
Rnd 5: (sc, inc) x6
Rnd 6: (sc, inc) x6, x6
Rnd 7: (sc, inc) x6
Rnd 8: inc x6
Rnd 9: inc x6

CRUST BORDER - Color B (Toast Brown)



STEP 2: JELLY & BUTTER RUFFLE




Attach **Color C (Purple)** of bread panel.

Attach **Color C (Purple)** for **jelly**. Work (sc, hdc) in the same st.

New **(new Color D (Yellow))** attached **below** matter round to create the butter ripple.

STEP 3: FACIAL FEATURES & ASSEMBLY



Safety Eye Placement (between Rnds 4 and 5, approx 5 sts apart)


Embroidered

Align the two bread panels and mattress-stitch or single-crochet it together, leaving a gap for.









STEP 4: SPIRAL TENTACLES (Make 8 in Purple)


1. Base Chain (ch 20-25 sts, approx 10" long)
2. Dense Multi-stitching (3 dc in each chain stitch from 2nd ch)
3. Dense Multi-stitching (3 dc in each chain stitch)



Secure all 8 finished tentacles attach all tentacles to bottom.

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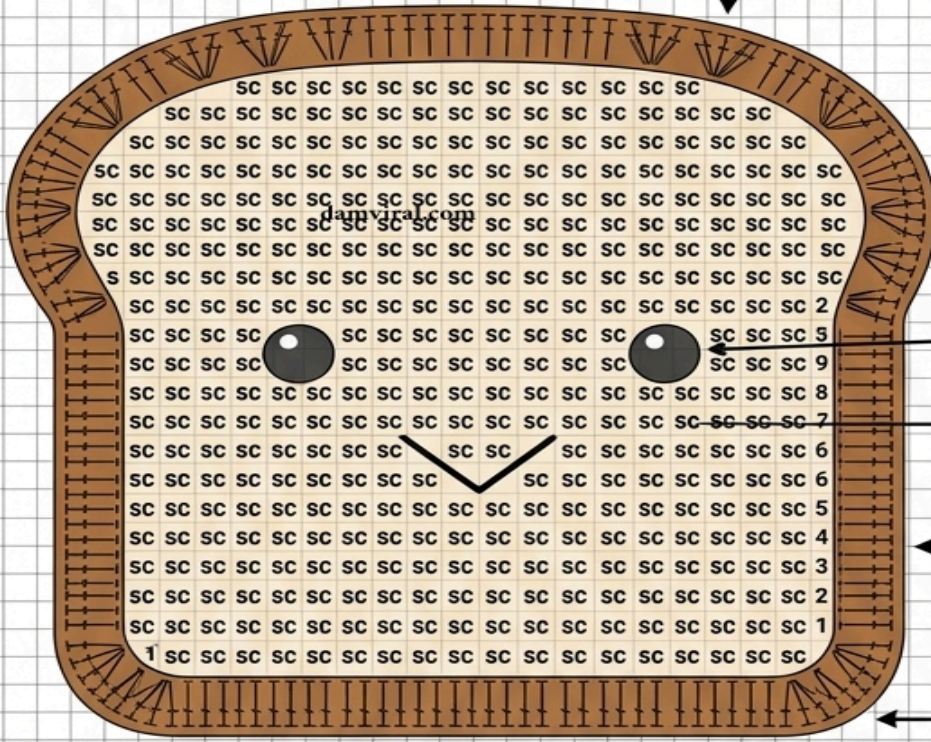

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Detailed US Stitch Key

- MR = Magic Ring
- ch = Chain
- s sc = Single Crochet
- ┆ hdc = Half Double Crochet
- ┆ dc = Double Crochet
- ┆ tr = Treble Crochet
- ↗ inc = Increase (sc inc)
- ↘ dec = Decrease (sc2tog)
- sl st = Slip Stitch
- st(s) = Stitch(es)

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Position of 12mm Safety Eyes (attach between Rows and 2)

Embroider smile using black yarn, 'v' shape over 8 sts.

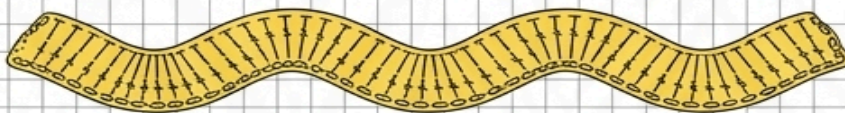
Bread Panel (work 2, with eyes/smile on one)

Joining Round

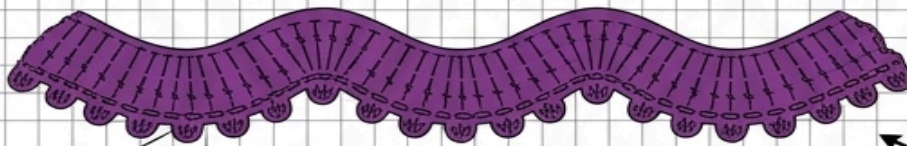
Ruffle Bottom Edge Pattern

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Pulp
(Creme Color asan anigurastic color),
US sc stitches (standard terminology used throughout)

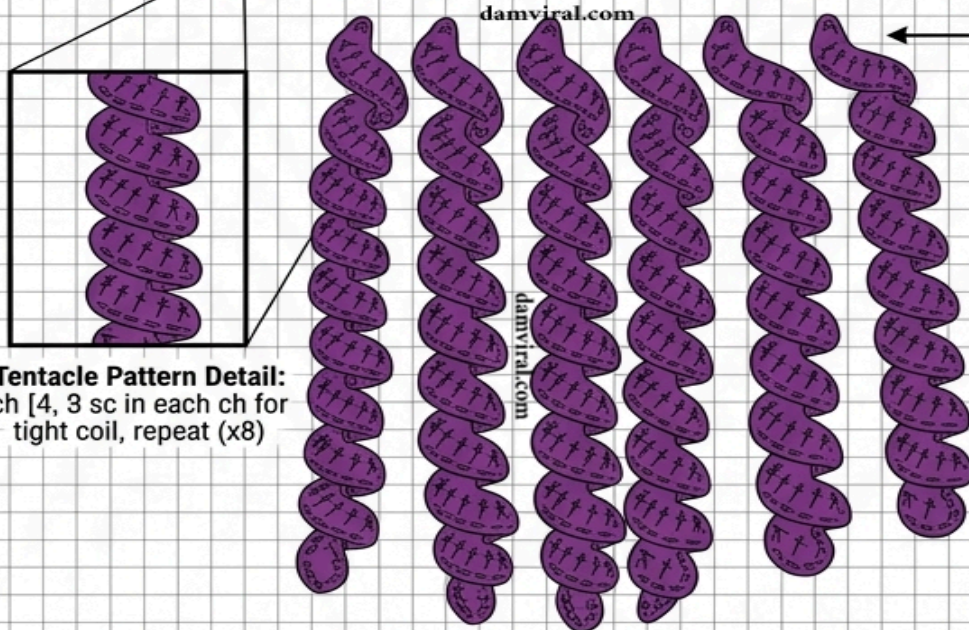


Peanut Butter Layer
(x2 rnds, sc inc in each st for ripple)



Jelly Layer
(x3 rnds, detailed ch-3 picot and sc inc ruffle pattern)

Tentacle Attachment Points



Tentacle Pattern Detail:
ch [4, 3 sc in each ch for tight coil, repeat (x8)

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Materials

- Super bulky chenille or blanket yarn (Size 6) in:
 - Cream (Color A – bread)
 - Toast Brown (Color B – crust)
 - Purple (Color C – jelly)
 - Yellow (Color D – butter)
- 6.5 mm (K–10.5) crochet hook
- 12 mm safety eyes
- Poly-fill stuffing
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker



US Crochet Abbreviations

- MR = Magic Ring
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- inc = increase (2 stitches in same stitch)
- dec = decrease
- sl st = slip stitch
- ch = chain



Step 1: Bread Body (Make 2 Panels)

Using **Color A (Cream)**

Start:

- Begin with a Magic Ring
- Work **6 sc into the ring**

Rounds: <https://damviral.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

- Round 1: 6 sc in MR
- Round 2: inc x6 (12 sts)
- Round 3: (sc, inc) x6 (18 sts)
- Round 4: (sc, inc) x6
- Round 5: (sc, inc) x6
- Round 6: (sc, inc) x6
- Round 7: (sc, inc) x6
- Round 8: inc x6
- Round 9: inc x6

You should now have a rounded square shape that resembles a slice of bread.

Crust Border:

Switch to **Color B (Toast Brown)**

- Work a round of **sc evenly around the edge**
- Fasten off and weave in ends

Make **2 identical panels**

Step 2: Jelly & Butter Ruffle

This creates the wavy filling around the bread edge.

Jelly Layer:

Attach **Color C (Purple)** to one bread panel edge

- Work (*sc, hdc*) into the same stitch repeatedly around the edge
- This creates a ruffled, wavy effect

Butter Layer:

Attach **Color D (Yellow)** just below the jelly

- Repeat the same (*sc, hdc*) pattern around
- This forms a second ruffle under the jelly

Fasten off and weave in ends

Step 3: Face & Assembly

Safety Eyes:

- Place between **Rounds 4 and 5**
- Space them about **5 stitches apart**

Face Embroidery:

- Use brown yarn to stitch a simple smiling mouth between the eyes
- Optional: add pink blush with yarn or fabric marker

Assembly:

- Place both bread panels together (right sides facing out)
- Align carefully

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Joining:

- Use **sc or mattress stitch** to join around the edges
- Leave a small gap at the bottom

Stuffing:

- Fill with **poly-fill** until plush and firm
- Close the gap securely

Step 4: Spiral Tentacles (Make 8)


Using Color C (Purple)

1. Base Chain:

- Chain **20–25 stitches** (about 10 inches long)

2. Spiral Formation:

- Starting in the **2nd chain from hook**, work:
 - **3 dc in each chain stitch**

This will naturally curl into a spiral 

3. Repeat:

- Make **8 tentacles total**

Attachment:

- Evenly attach all tentacles to the bottom of the sandwich
- Sew securely using a tapestry needle



Finished Size

- Approximately **11 inches (28 cm)** tall
- Life-size plush look

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
