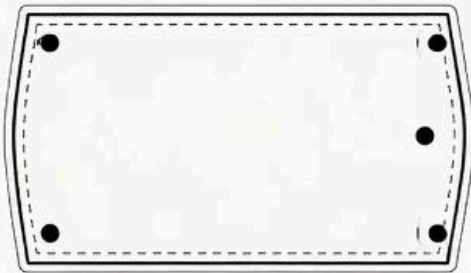
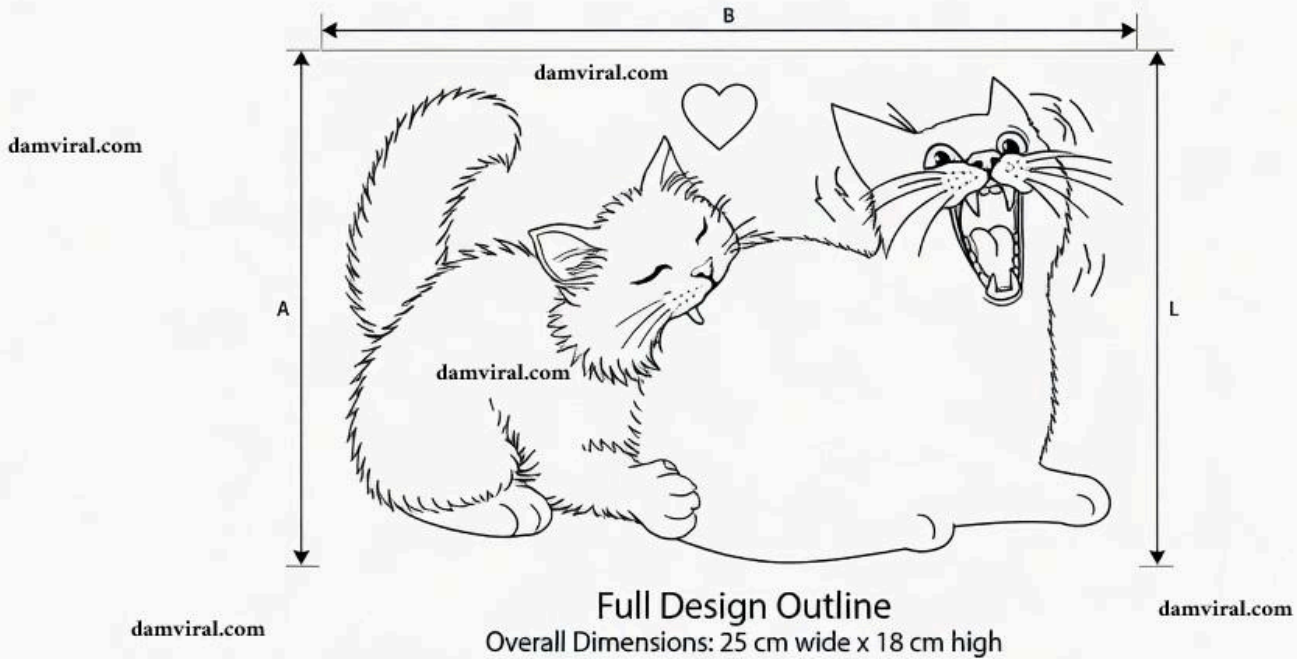


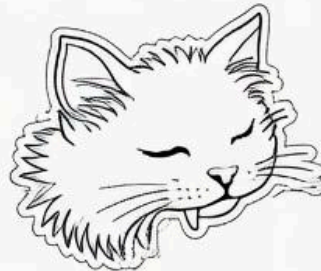

🐾 Full DIY Tutorial: Cute Cat Design Project (Based on the Provided Pattern)

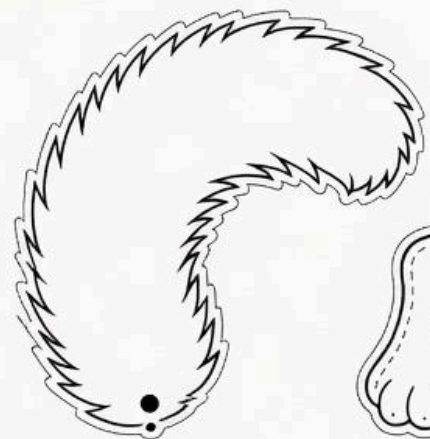

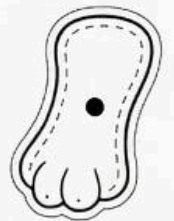
White Cat Body
- 7.5 cm wide x 6.0 cm high



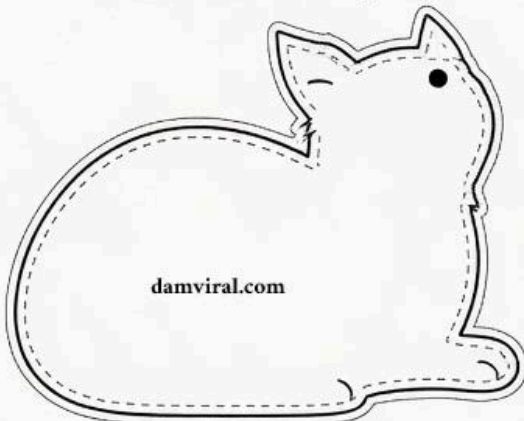
White Cat Head

- 8.0 cm wide x 7.5 cm high



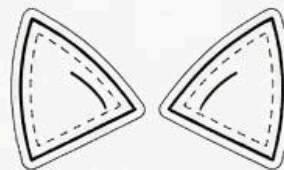
White Cat Paw

with open hissing mouth
- 5.5 cm wide x 6.0 cm high



Black Cat Ears
- 3.0 cm wide x 2.5 cm high

Small Red Heart
- 2.0 cm wide x 2.0 cm high

COMPLETE TUTORIAL: EMBROIDERING THE REACTION CATS ON DENIM (US MATERIALS & METHODS)

1 PREPARATION & MATERIALS
 WASH & PRESS DENIM TAUTLY HOOP FABRIC TRANSFER PATTERN

  
 15CM wombroidery hoop
 Water-soluble fabric pen

MATERIALS:

- Medium-wash cotton denim
- Size 10 Crewel needle
- Assorted shades of US-brand 6-strand cotton embroidery floss (e.g., DMC Blanc, 310, 415, E310 (satin white), 666 (heart red))

MEASUREMENT 1
 The finished embroidery area should be approx. 12 CM x 10 CM

2 KEY EMBROIDERY STITCHES & METHODS

1. SPLIT STITCH (A) & OUTLINE STITCH (B) 3. SATIN STITCH (D)

3 THE STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS
 ALL MEASUREMENTS IN CM

1 START WITH THE BLACK CAT.

 SPLIT STITCH OUTLINES
 LONG & SHORT STITCH FILL
 US Thread 310

2 ADD TEXTURE SHADING (BLACK CAT).

 E310 satin lights
 SHADING METHODS (C) for DEPTH

3 EMBROIDER THE WHITE CAT.

 415 into DMC TUFTS
 Use blending from light grey (415) into white (DMC Blanc)
 Add specific fur tufts with different thread directions
 Paws un 2 CM wide
 MEASUREMENT 2: 2 CM wide.

4 STITCH KEY DETAILS & HEART.

 SATIN STITCH (D)
 SHOCK LINES
 ADD REACTION

5 ATTACH WHISKERS & REACTION MARKS.

 Use BULLION KNOT (E) for the long, fine whiskers
 1.5 CM
 MEASUREMENT 3: Whiskers extend to 2.5 CM from face.

6 FINISHING & CARE.

 SOAK → DRY → PRESS from BACK
 TOTAL EMBROIDERY AREA: ~12 CM WIDE x 10 CM HIGH

Materials You'll Need

Before starting, gather everything to avoid interruptions:

- Printed pattern (scaled correctly to **25 cm wide x 18 cm high**)
- Fabric or felt in two colors (white and black)
- Small piece of red fabric (for the heart)
- Fabric scissors
- Pins or clips
- Fabric marker or chalk
- Sewing machine or hand sewing needle
- Thread (matching your fabrics)
- Stuffing (polyfill or cotton)
- Optional: embroidery thread for details
- Optional: fabric glue

Step 1: Understand the Pattern Layout

The full design measures:

- **Width (B): 25 cm**
- **Height (A/L): 18 cm**

Each piece in the pattern has specific dimensions:

- White Cat Body: 7.5 cm x 6.0 cm
- White Cat Head: 4.2 cm x 4.5 cm
- White Cat Tail: 8.0 cm x 7.5 cm
- White Cat Paw: 2.5 cm x 2.5 cm
- Black Cat Body: 11.0 cm x 9.5 cm
- Black Cat Head: 5.5 cm x 6.0 cm
- Black Cat Ears: 3.0 cm x 2.5 cm (each)
- Heart: 2.0 cm x 2.0 cm

The dots on each piece indicate where you will attach or align parts.

Step 2: Print and Cut the Pattern

Print the design at **100% scale** (no resizing). Double-check with a ruler that the full width is 25 cm.

Cut out each individual piece carefully along the outer lines.

Step 3: Transfer Pattern to Fabric

Place each paper piece onto the corresponding fabric:

- White pieces → white fabric
- Black pieces → black fabric
- Heart → red fabric

Trace around each piece using a fabric marker. Add about **0.5 cm seam allowance** around each shape unless already included.

Cut out all fabric pieces neatly.

Step 4: Sew Individual Pieces

Start assembling each part separately:

White Cat Pieces

- Sew the **body**, leaving a small opening to stuff
- Sew the **head**, also leaving an opening
- Sew the **tail** and lightly stuff for fluffiness
- Sew the **paw** and stuff slightly

Turn all pieces right-side out after sewing.

Black Cat Pieces

- Sew the **body**, leaving an opening
- Sew the **head** (with open mouth detail if desired)
- Attach the **ears** to the head before closing it

Stuff all parts evenly and close openings with small stitches.



Step 5: Assemble the Cats

Now bring everything together:

- Attach the **white cat head** to its body
- Sew the **tail** to the back
- Attach the **paw** to the front

For the black cat:

- Attach the **head** to the body
- Position the **ears** symmetrically
- Angle the head slightly to match the playful expression in the design

Use the dots from the pattern as guides for placement.



Step 6: Add the Heart Detail

Cut out the small heart (2.0 cm x 2.0 cm) from red fabric.

You can:

- Sew it between the cats
- Or glue it slightly above them for a floating effect

Step 7: Add Facial Details

Use embroidery thread or fabric paint to add:

- Eyes (closed for white cat, open for black cat)
- Nose and mouth
- Whiskers

Keep expressions consistent with the pattern—one calm, one playful/hissing.

Step 8: Final Assembly and Finishing Touches

Position both cats side by side:

- White cat slightly leaning into black cat
- Black cat reacting with a surprised or playful expression

Secure them together with stitches where their bodies touch.

Check all seams, trim loose threads, and adjust stuffing if needed.

You're Done!

You've now created a fully detailed cat design based exactly on the diagram. This project works great as:

- A decorative piece
- A handmade gift
- A patchwork or applique design
