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
STEP-BY-STEP TUTORIAL: CRAFTING THE PATRIOTIC POPPY LOG CABIN QUILT

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
KEY US QUILTING & SEWING METHODS

-  **1. PIECING:** JOINING FABRIC PIECES WITH PRECISION.
-  **2. APPLIQUÉ:** ATTACHING SHAPES (e.g., STARS, FLOWERS) BY SEWING.
-  **3. QUILTING:** FUSING THREE LAYERS WITH STITCHES.
-  **4. BINDING:** FINISHING THE EDGES.
-  **5. TOP-STITCHING:** VISIBLE STITCHES FOR STRENGTH AND DETAIL.

START TO FINISH: ANATOMY




1. PREPARE YOUR PATTERN



2. LOG CABIN BLOCK ASSEMBLY

USE NAVY, BLUE, AND CREAM FABRICS. START WITH THE CENTER (RED SQUARE) AND ADD STRIPS (LOGS).


BLOCK MEASUREMENT: ~18CM x 18CM



3. PIECE THE MAIN GRID


ARRANGE AND SEW BLOCKS (6 columns x 8 rows) TO CREATE THE GRID (4x6 shown as example).

GRID MEASUREMENT: ~72CM x 90CM




4. CREATE AND APPLY THE CENTRAL FLAG

SEW RED & WHITE STRIPS (e.g., 2cm wide), ADD STAR BLUE PANEL (e.g., 20cm x 30cm). CUT TO FLAG SHAPE (~35CM x 60CM). APPLY TO CENTER WITH FUSIBLE WEB AND EDGE STITCHING.




5. ADD FINAL APPLIQUÉ & QUILTING

APPLIQUÉ THE FLOWERS




HAND-APPLIQUÉD STARS & CENTRAL STAR



FREE-MOTION QUILTING MACHINE or HAND-QUILT LINEAR TEXTURE ACROSS ALL LAYERS.

6. BINDING AND FINISHING



IMPORTANT MEASUREMENTS (ALL IN CM)

Finished Quilt:	90 x 120
Individual Block:	18 x 18
Central Flag (Cut Shape):	35 x 60
Central Star:	15 wide
Edge Stars:	3 wide
Poppy Flowers:	12 diameter
Fabric Strips for Log Cabin:	3 wide (approx)

All measurements are estimated for this specific visual example and should be scaled as needed.

Key Quilting & Sewing Methods You'll Use

Before starting, understand the core techniques:

Piecing: Sewing fabric pieces together precisely to form blocks.

Appliqué: Attaching decorative shapes (like stars and flowers) onto a fabric background.

Quilting: Stitching together three layers—top, batting, and backing.

Binding: Finishing the edges of the quilt.

Top-stitching: Visible stitching that adds both strength and decorative detail.

Step 1: Prepare Your Pattern

Start by planning your quilt layout.

- Create or print a **design template** approximately **60 cm wide by 90 cm high** (about 24" x 36").
- Sketch or map out where your log cabin blocks, central flag, stars, and poppies will go.
- This template will guide your layout and proportions.

Step 2: Assemble the Log Cabin Blocks

This quilt uses the classic log cabin block style.

- Choose **navy, blue, and cream fabrics**.
- Begin each block with a **red square center**.
- Sew strips ("logs") around the center square in alternating colors.
- Each finished block should measure **18 cm x 18 cm** (about 7" x 7").
- Press seams flat as you go for accuracy.

Tip: Keep seam allowances consistent ($\frac{1}{4}$ inch standard in the U.S.).

Step 3: Piece the Main Grid

Now assemble your quilt top using the blocks.

- Arrange your blocks into a grid: **6 columns x 8 rows**.
- This creates a full quilt size of approximately **72 cm x 90 cm** (about 28" x 35") for the central grid.
- Sew blocks together row by row, then join the rows.
- Match seams carefully to keep everything aligned.

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Step 4: Create and Apply the Central Flag

- Sew **red and white strips** (each about **2 cm wide**) to form the striped portion.
- Add a **blue rectangle (star field)** about **20 cm x 30 cm**.
- Cut the assembled flag into a stylized flag shape approximately **35 cm x 60 cm**.
- Position the flag in the center of your quilt top.
- Attach using **fusible web** and secure with edge stitching.

Tip: Use a zigzag or blanket stitch for a clean appliqué edge.

Step 5: Add Final Appliqué & Quilting

Now add decorative elements and texture.

Appliqué the Poppy Flowers

- Create layered petals for a realistic look.
- Each flower should be about **12 cm in diameter**.
- Add stems (30–50 cm long) and leaves.
- Stitch details to give dimension.

Add Stars

- One **central star**: about **15 cm wide**.
- Smaller stars along edges: about **3 cm wide**.
- Use appliqué techniques to attach them.

Quilt All Layers

- Layer your quilt: **top + batting (cotton recommended) + backing (solid navy fabric)**.
- Use **free-motion quilting** or straight-line stitching.
- Quilt across all layers to secure everything and add texture.

Tip: Start quilting from the center and move outward to avoid wrinkles.

Step 6: Binding and Finishing

Finish your quilt cleanly.

- Cut binding strips about **6 cm wide**, fold them in half lengthwise.
- Sew binding around the edges of the quilt.
- Fold over and hand-stitch or machine-stitch to secure.
- Trim loose threads and press the finished quilt.



Important Measurements (Quick Reference)

- Finished Quilt: **90 cm x 120 cm** (approx. 35" x 47")
- Log Cabin Block: **18 cm x 18 cm**
- Central Flag: **35 cm x 60 cm**
- Central Star: **15 cm wide**
- Small Stars: **3 cm wide**
- Poppy Flowers: **12 cm diameter**
- Fabric Strips (logs): **3 cm wide**



Final Tips for Success

- Pre-wash fabrics to prevent shrinking.
- Use high-quality cotton for best results.
- Press seams frequently—this makes a huge difference.
- Take your time with alignment and appliqué placement.
- Don't worry about perfection—quilting is both craft and art.

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
