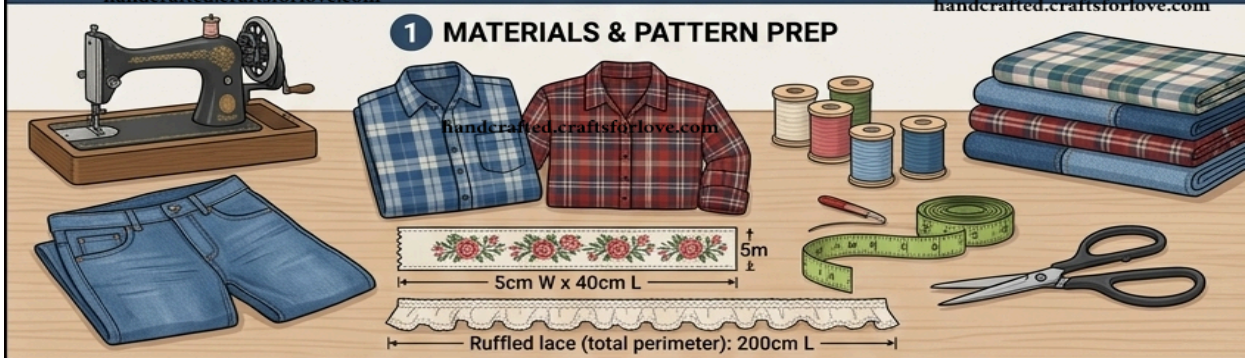


🧵 Guide to Crafting a Patchwork Remote Cushion (From Start to Finish)

This step-by-step tutorial will walk you through everything you need to create a beautiful patchwork cushion with a built-in pocket—perfect for holding a remote or small items. It's beginner-friendly but detailed enough for great results. Let's get started!

GUIDE TO CRAFTING THE PATCHWORK REMOTE CUSHION: From Start to Finish

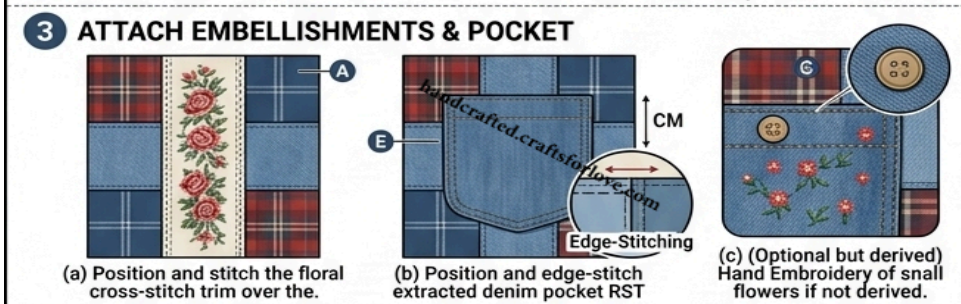


LEGEND OF KEY METHODS

CM measurements (Right Sides Together) for all steps.

A APPLIQUE
Stitching fabric shapes onto background ground (trim, pocket).

E HAND EMBROIDERY/ CROSS-STITCH
Hand-worked detailed features, and stitching ruffles and raimeries.



CM CM measurements specified for all steps.

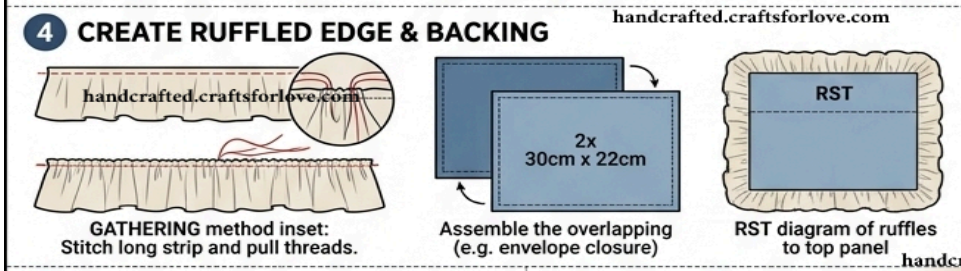
E HAND EMBROIDERY/ CROSS-STITCH
Hand-worked detailed features.

P PIECING
Joining varied fabric shapes (forming patchwork grid).

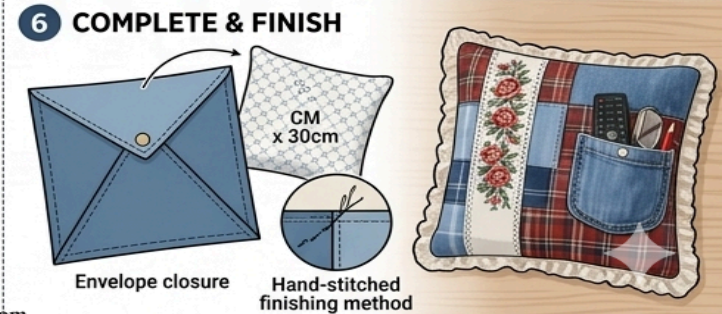
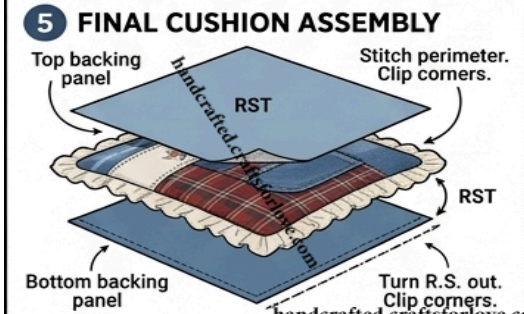
G GATHERING
Stitching and pulling fabric for ruffles to maaning and backed.

ES EDGE-STITCHING
Visible, clean, secure stitching along the very edge.

Q QUILTING
Layering, but derived Layering and stitching with batting.

Step 1: Materials & Pattern Preparation

Before sewing anything, gather all your supplies and prepare your materials.

What You'll Need:

- Sewing machine (or needle for hand sewing)
- Old denim jeans (for pocket and fabric pieces)
- Two plaid shirts (or similar patterned fabric)
- Extra fabric for backing
- Threads in coordinating colors
- Fabric scissors
- Measuring tape
- Pins or clips

Decorative Materials:

- Floral embroidered trim (approx. 5 cm x 40 cm)
- Ruffled lace (approx. 200 cm total perimeter length)

Cutting Your Fabric:

- Cut **9 squares**, each measuring **12 cm x 12 cm**
 - Mix denim and plaid fabrics for a patchwork look
- Cut:
 - 1 floral trim strip: **5 cm x 40 cm**
 - 1 denim pocket piece (reuse from jeans if possible)

Step 2: Form the Patchwork Top

Now you'll create the main front panel of your cushion.

Layout:

- Arrange your **9 squares in a 3x3 grid**
- Alternate patterns (denim and plaid) for visual contrast

Sewing (Piecing):

- Place squares **right sides together (RST)**
- Sew each row using a standard seam allowance (~1 cm or 3/8 inch)
- Join the rows together to form a complete square panel

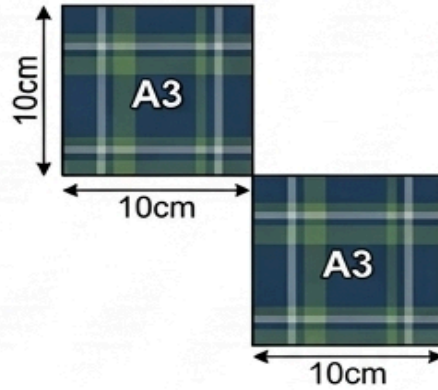
PATCHWORK CUSHION COVER TEMPLATE (A4 PRINTABLE) - MEASUREMENTS IN CM

CENTRAL PANEL (FLOWERS) - Cut 1 (Linen with Embroidery)

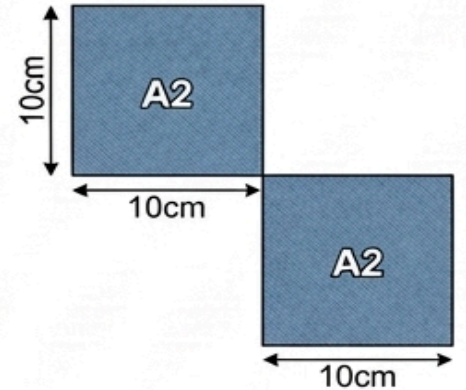


EMBROIDERY

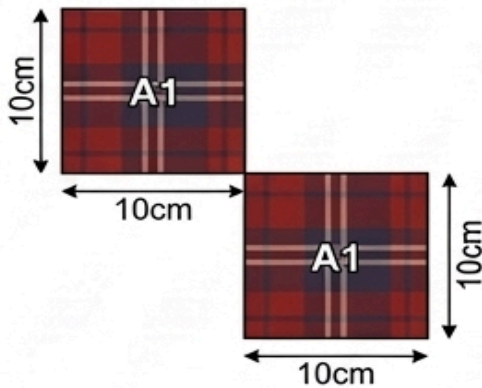
LATERAL SQUARE (A3) - Cut 2 (Green/Blue Plaid)



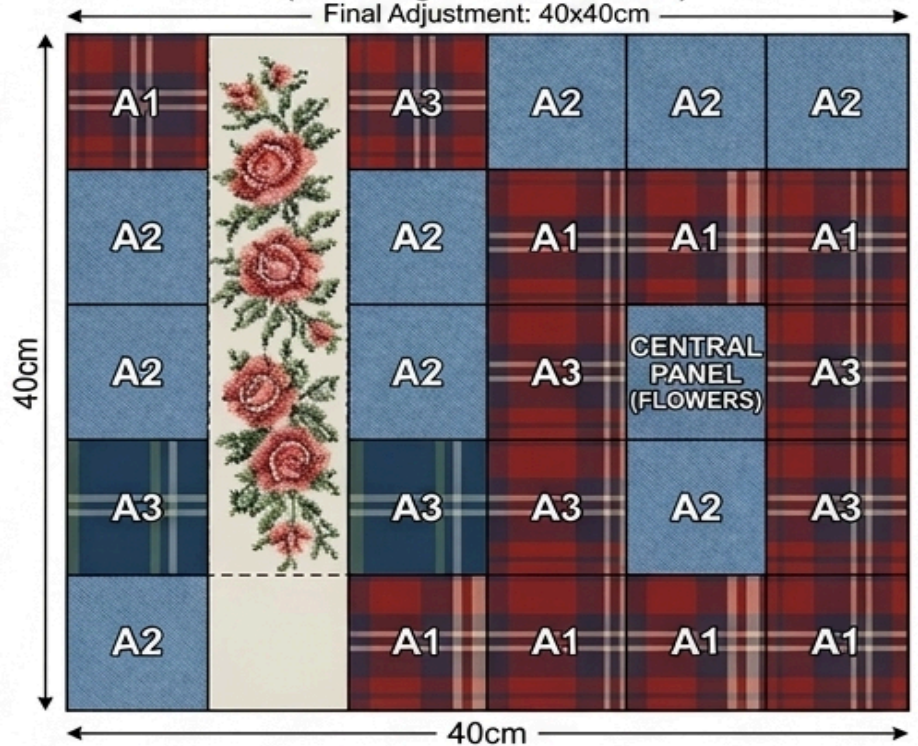
LATERAL SQUARE (A2) - Cut 2 (Light Denim)



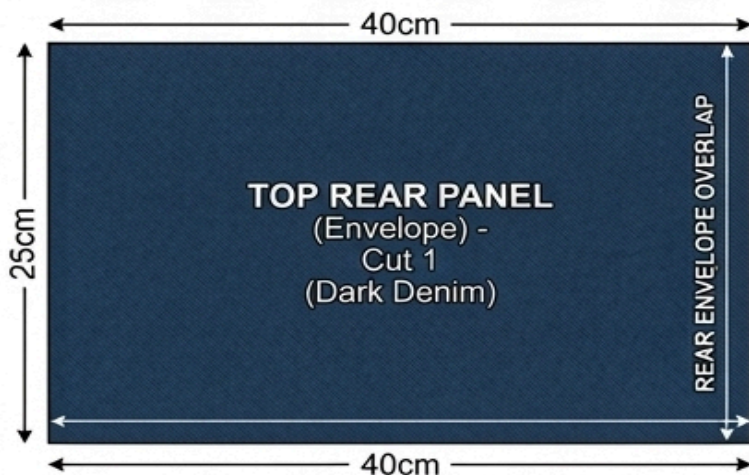
LATERAL SQUARE (A1) - Cut 2 (Red/Blue Plaid)



COMPLETE FRONT PANEL (BASE) - Cut 1 (Wadding or Cotton Base)



TOP REAR PANEL (Envelope) - Cut 1 (Dark Denim)



RUFFLE DETAIL (LACE) - Cut 4 strips (Lace/Gathered Fabric)



BOTTOM REAR PANEL (Envelope) - Cut 1 (Dark Denim)

✓ Final Size:

- Your patchwork panel should measure approximately **30 cm x 30 cm**

🌸 Step 3: Attach Embellishments & Pocket

This step adds both style and functionality!

(a) Add Floral Trim:

- Position the floral embroidered strip vertically over the patchwork
- Stitch along both long edges to secure it (this is appliqué)

(b) Attach the Pocket:

- Cut a pocket from your denim jeans (or sew one)
- Place it slightly off-center on the patchwork
- Edge-stitch around the sides and bottom to attach securely

(c) Optional Embroidery:

- Add small embroidered flowers on the pocket if desired
- Use hand embroidery or cross-stitch for a personal touch 🌻

🎀 Step 4: Create Ruffled Edge & Backing

🧵 Making the Ruffle:

- Take your lace strip (200 cm long)
- Use a gathering stitch:
 - Sew a long loose stitch along one edge
 - Pull the thread to gather the fabric evenly

📌 Attach Ruffle:

- Pin the ruffle around the edge of your patchwork panel
- Make sure it's evenly distributed
- Stitch in place

🧵 Prepare Backing:

- Cut **2 rectangles**, each measuring **30 cm x 22 cm**
- These will overlap to form an envelope-style closure

Step 5: Final Cushion Assembly

Now it all comes together!



Layering:

- Place the patchwork front panel **right side up**
- Place backing panels on top **right side down**, overlapping in the middle



Stitching:

- Pin all layers together
- Sew around the entire perimeter
- Clip the corners to reduce bulk



Turn:

- Turn the cushion cover right side out through the envelope opening
- Push out corners neatly



Step 6: Complete & Finish



Final Touches:

- Insert your cushion insert (30 cm x 30 cm)
- Smooth everything out



Optional:

- Hand-stitch any loose areas for reinforcement
- Iron lightly for a polished finish
